INFRASTRUCTURE

To provide a truly enriching environment that contributes to the holistic development of the student and to nourish overt and hidden talents; the school has set up two Tennis Courts, Basketball Court, Cricket net practice, Skating rink, Volley Ball Court, Football Court, Athletics. The school has a 7 acre land with 3.5 as built up area and the rest is devoted for the Playground. All our classrooms are equipped with SmartBoards for interactive learning purposes.

The school also has indoor game facilities like- Carrom, Chess, Taekwondo, Gymnastics and Table Tennis.

Besides, The school boasts of a wooden dance floor, a well designed Art room, an Auditorium for competitions, a computer Lab with 30 computerswith the latest software which ensures high computer literacy for children; well equipped Physics, Biology and Chemistry Labs and also a Junior Lab. SCHOOL UNIFORM
